

# TORONTO ISLAND CANOE CLUB

## 2019 Fee Schedule

*All fees are effective May 15, 2019 and run for 12 months. Fees will not be pro-rated.*

General Membership \$145/yr  
(Includes annual base fee of \$120 plus \$25 annual building improvement fee)  
*General membership entitles one adult (19+) full access to the club year round, one vote at the Annual General Meeting, 5 guest passes, and the option to store your personal canoe, kayak or SUP upon payment of an additional fee.*

Affiliate Membership \$60/yr  
*(available only to regular guests/partners of a General Member. Affiliates are entitled to use the club facility)*

### **Additional Fees (General Members only)**

Boat Storage (May 15, 2019 - May 14, 2020)

Sprint Storage (C1/K1) \$120  
*(year round storage for one vessel on designated indoor rack. Vessel is not covered by club insurance)*

SUP Storage \$120  
*(year round storage for one board on designated indoor rack. Board is not covered by club insurance.)*

Recreational Canoe or Sea Kayak Storage \$360  
*(year round storage for one pleasure canoe on designated outdoor rack at shoreline. Vessel is not covered by club insurance. Under special circumstances space may be made available inside at additional cost)*

Locker \$40/yr  
*(limited lockers available, Member must supply their own lock)*

Additional Guest Passes \$50 for 6 passes  
*(Guest passes are to be used when you have non-members using the club facilities. All General Memberships include 5 passes.)*

Dolly or stand fee (location to be designated) \$200
